- Klingon Houses are generally named for either the current Head of House or an illustrious ancestor. Who is your House named after?
- What great deeds (if any) earned them this honor?
- Genealogy and patronymics are very important to Klingons: name the last three generations of your House (father, grandfather, great-grandfather).
- Klingon warriors are noted for their courageous deeds. What (if any) are the great deeds of the warriors you just listed?
- What noble deeds (if any) are YOU noted for?
- Klingon warriors and their noble houses- whether great or small- are immortalized in song. What songs (if any) are sung about your ancestors or House?
- Not every Klingon is a valiant hero, and each House has its secret shame or embarrassment. Who (if any) of your kin have embarrassed or shamed their House (whether publicly or in secret)?
- Does your House have rivalries with other Houses? If so, why?
- Klingon society is a web of loyalty, fealty, alliances, and rivalries. To whom does your House owe its allegiance?
- Who owes your House their loyalties?
- Who are your House's friends?
- Who are their enemies?
- And upon whom can you rely when the enemy gathers at your gate?
- Relics and heirlooms from warriors past (such as the Sword of Kahless) are often passed from warrior to warrior and generation to generation. What relics (if any) of the glorious past does your House possess, and why are they special?
- Who is your current Head of House? Who is his immediate heir? How are you related to them?
- Are there any other notable members of your House?
